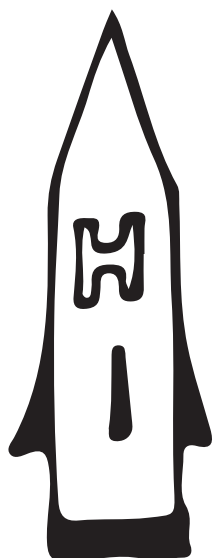


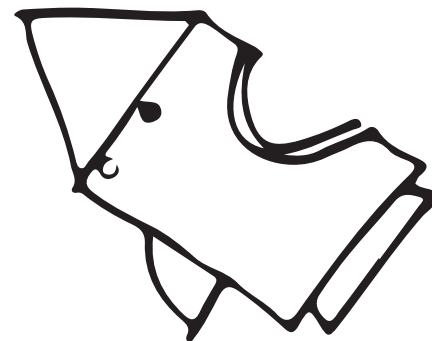
## HOW ARE YOU GOING TO DO THAT?
